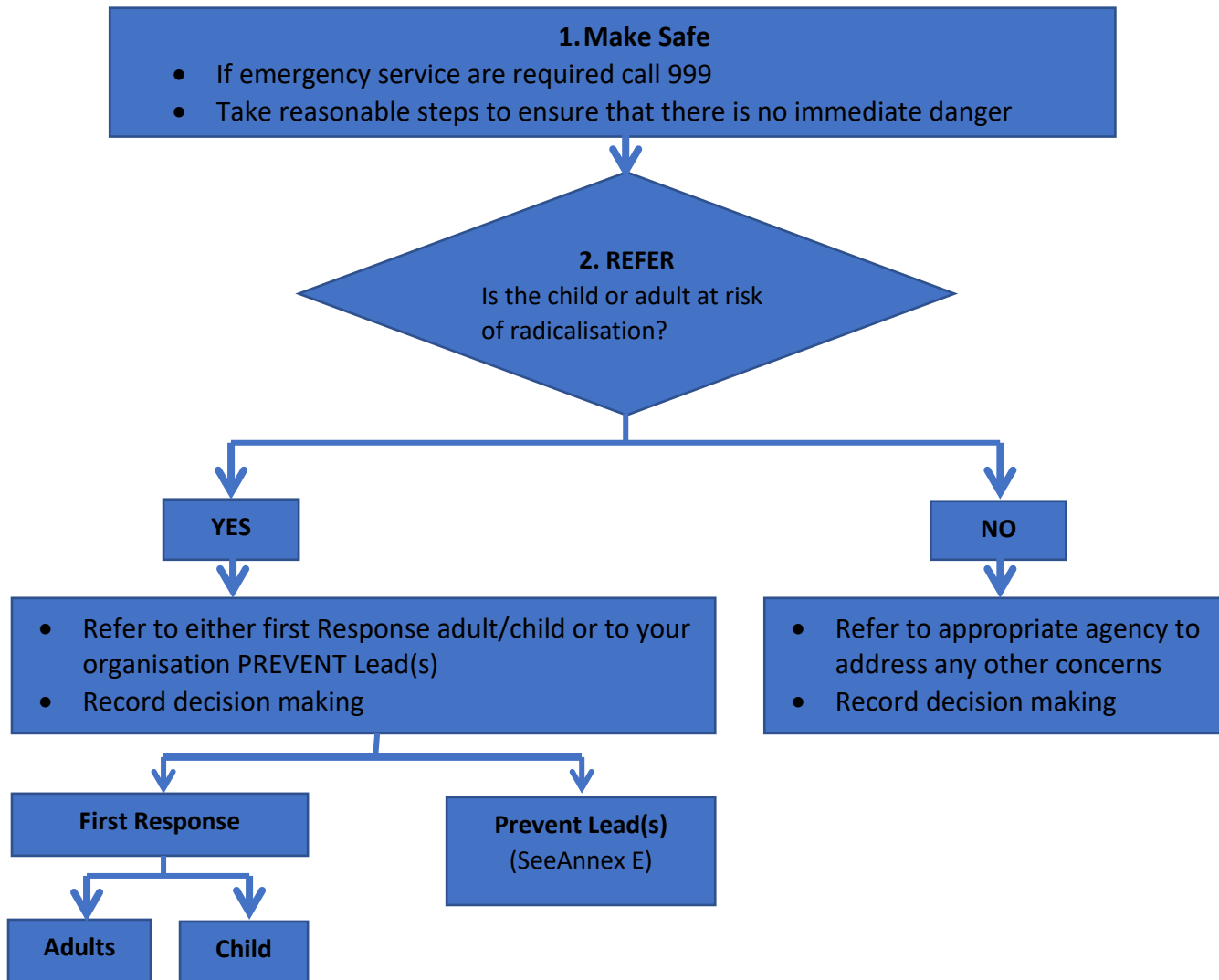


PREVENT - How to Report Concerns in Buckinghamshire
