This term we will be holding a cake and coffee morning to discuss the new Parent's Portal by Autism Early Support (AES) which been launched in Buckinghamshire as a free resource for local parents.

I have included the information below for you to access. Buckinghamshire Council have partnered with the creators of the platform, specialist local charity Autism Early Support to offer this service.

The portal provides early help and guidance and an online community of support. It is a self-guided learning tool, designed for parents of children aged 2-17 years who:

- Have noticed differences in their child and they're exploring neurodivergence
- Have Googled, *Is my child autistic, or what is ADHD?*
- Have an autistic child(ren)
- Are awaiting a Neurodevelopmental assessment
